Lead choreographer, Ensemble

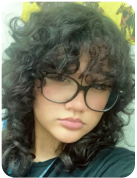

Mrs. Brice

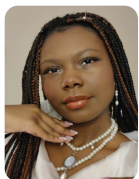

Head of set, Florenz Ziegfeld, Jr.

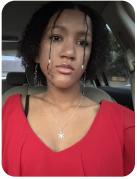

Mrs. Meeker & others

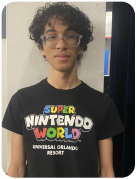

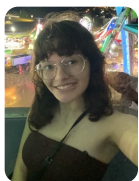

Tech Director/Lighting Tech

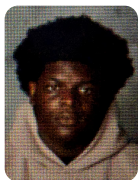

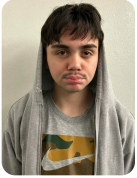

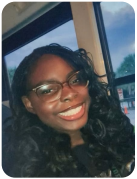
