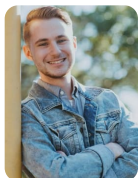
Karl Rogers

Ethan Walls

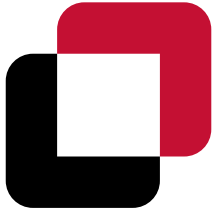
