Cady

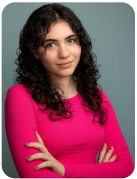

Regina

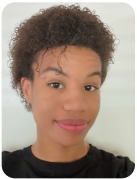

Damian/Dance Captain

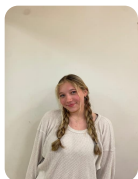

Mr. Duvall & others

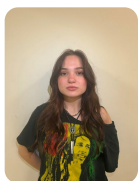

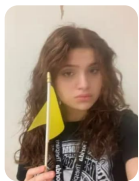
# Production Team

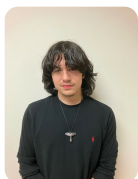
(Senior) This is my second time working in the lighting booth, and I couldn't be more excited! I'm ready to learn, collaborate and help create a show that shines.

Set Team

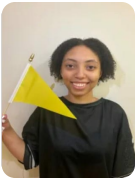
